

The Department of Design at the Stuttgart State Academy of Art and Design invites applications for the position of

## **Full Professor for Industrial Design**

(Bes.-Gr. W 3) which will commence on 1 October 2018.

The academy is an institution for higher arts education in the fields of architecture, art education, art history, conservation-restoration, design, and fine art. The position requires broad theoretical, practical and artistic knowledge and skills in the field in order to work successfully within an art and design based academic community. The successful candidate is expected to have a wide-ranging design portfolio as well as an international and interdisciplinary approach to teaching and research.

### Job description:

In addition to conduction of his/her own design practice and research, the Chair for Industrial Design will teach within the diploma program, take joint responsibility for the program, and guide young academics and designers. As a member of the academic and professional community, she/he will take part in interdisciplinary and international collaborations as well as contemporary discourse, and develop the field of industrial design. Furthermore, professors are expected to participate in service to the academy's community and its academic self-government.

### Requirements:

1. Academic degree in industrial design (or equivalent qualification),
2. teaching qualification and (preferably international) teaching experience,
3. doctoral degree, or practice based research, or excellent track-record in the field of industrial design outside academia, and a
4. special interest and ability to introduce multi-disciplinary approaches to teaching, learning and research.

Alternatively, candidates may apply if they can demonstrate

1. an outstanding track-record in the field of industrial design, and
2. teaching qualifications as well as (preferably international) teaching experience.

The Stuttgart State Academy of Art and Design is an equal opportunity employer. It is committed to increase the proportion of women amongst its academic and artistic members of staff and particularly invites applications by female candidates. Applications from disabled persons with essentially the same qualifications will be given preference.
