The Staatliche Akademie der Bildenden Künste Stuttgart (Stuttgart State Academy of Art and Design) has a full professorship to offer in the Department of Fine Art. Applications are invited for the following position:

Professor of Digital and Time-based Art

(public service salary group W3 / Bes.-Gr. W3).

Applications are invited from artists with an excellent artistic practice within the field of contemporary art. Openness towards analogue art forms and an interest in transdisciplinary projects are expected of candidates.

Tasks

The successful candidate will be responsible of his or her class for digital and time-based art. Furthermore, the candidate will be in charge of developing a digital and time-based art curriculum within the Department of Fine Art. The candidate will be expected to work collaboratively with colleagues, to advance the subject area and to share expertise. At the institutional level, the successful candidate will be required to serve on the department's and institution's academic self-governance boards.

Required qualifications

- A graduate degree,
- pedagogical aptitude and teaching experience and
- excellent artistic achievements in digital and time-based art.

If the formal requirements are not met, applications are accepted if a candidate demonstrates

1. *outstanding* artistic achievements in digital and time-based art, and
2. pedagogical aptitude and teaching experience.

Candidates

In accordance with current equality laws, the Academy has made a commitment to increase the proportion of women on its academic staff. The Academy therefore encourages women artists to apply. Female applicants with equal qualifications, competence and professional achievements will be given preference. Individuals with disabilities will be treated preferentially provided they are suitably qualified.

Should the official requirements for an appointment in the German civil service (Beamtenverhältnis) not be fulfilled, an employment contract outside this system is possible.

Application process

Applications for this vacancy (one pdf including a cover letter, a CV, certificates, a concise list of teaching experience, projects and publications and a relevant selection of publications – maximum size: 10 MB) are to be made online and should be submitted no later than **October 17th 2019**.
