LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	Courses are held in German; however, most German students and academic staff are fluent in English. A sound level of German (at least A2-B2) is of great advantage but not mandatory. English language skills should be excellent (at least B2-C2).

INSURANCE	Students from other European Union (EU) countries who are already insured in their country of origin do not have to insure themselves in Germany. With the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) they can directly go to a doctor and use their insurance card there.
